

Lincoln Elementary Schools #27

Regular Meeting - Board of Education

April 18, 2018

The March meeting of the Board of Education of District #27 was called to order by President Rohrer at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Administration Office.

Members present at roll call were: Hullinger, Bates, Grunder, Montgomery, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, and Rohrer. Supt. Froebe and the following were also in attendance: Christa Healy, Ginger Chaudoin, Chris Allen, Mike Workman, Kelly Bogdanic, Marsha Dallas, Colleen Jodlowski, Mr. & Mrs. Van Hook, Susan Rohrer, Sue Kuhlmyer, Joan Kuhlmyer and Ashley Phillips.

- Consent Agenda** Member Stoltzenburg made a motion, seconded by Member Grunder, to approve the Consent Agenda as follows: minutes from the March 21, 2018 regular session meeting; bills for April 2018; destruction of 19 month old closed session minutes; amend the 2017-18 school calendar to reflect use of two snow days, and show May 29, 2018 as the last day of school; and the IESA Membership renewal. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Public Comment** The Board listened to a proposal from Tom Van Hook regarding a Student Safety and Protection resolution.
- Suspensions** Upon the recommendation of Supt. Froebe, Member Grunder made a motion, seconded by Member Hullinger, to approve the student suspensions as presented. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Supt. Report** Supt. Froebe reported on the following: new, more durable, bleachers were installed at LJHS over spring break; severely clogged pipes, which caused water issues in the elevator shaft at the district office were replaced; the principals, staff, Mrs. Dallas and Mrs. Coffey deserve credit for again successfully administering the PARCC assessment; PERA Joint Committee will be meeting next week to assess our new evaluation tool, and to prepare for the required transition from 75% to 70% professional practice rating and 25% to 30% student growth rating; we will be hosting the Instructional Coaches Round Table at the district office next week; based on the new Evidence-Based Funding formula, we will be receiving an additional \$216,013.67 for FY18; Mr. Workman is in the process of coordinating summer school again at LJHS, and we will also be having our Kindergarten Academy at Northwest; kindergarten registration will be next week at the individual buildings; the LJHS School Play will be April 27th and 28th; and due to the two ice days in January, our last day of student attendance will now be Tuesday, May 29th. Graduation will remain on Wednesday, May 23rd at 3:00 p.m.. Member Stoltzenburg made a motion, seconded by Member Alexander, to approve the report as presented. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder,

and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.

- FMLA Member Bates made a motion, seconded by Member Grunder, to approve the Family Medical Leave Request as presented. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.

- Board Policy Member Montgomery made a motion, seconded by Member Stoltzenburg, to give final approval to changes to Board Policy 2.260, 4.40, 4.40-AP and 7:340-E2 as presented. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Curriculum Member Bates made a motion, seconded by Member Alexander, to approve the curriculum change as presented, beginning with the 2018-19 school year. Health class would be incorporated into 7th grade Physical Education, and 7th and 8th grade students would receive a semester of STEM class with an emphasis on 21st century learning skills and informational literacy. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Closed Session At 6:27 p.m. Member Grunder made a motion, seconded by Member Hullinger, to adjourn to a closed session to discuss appointment, employment, dismissal, compensation, or performance of specific employees, and collective bargaining matters. Members Montgomery, Bates, Hullinger, Alexander, Stoltzenburg, Grunder, and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.

- School Safety The Board discussed the intention of forming a committee to ensure the continuing safety of our schools and students.
