- Supt. Report**      Supt. Froebe reported on the following items: thanks to the Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital CATCH program, Adams School received a new drinking fountain with water bottle filling station; the swings at Central have been repaired; great turnout of parents for Parent/Teacher Conferences on October 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, with nearly 91% of K-6 parents attending; PARCC results show 35% of our 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders Meet/Exceed. LJHS scores increased 30% to 37%, and Central increased to 40%. The efforts of our teachers and administrators who prepare our students for success are greatly appreciated; received a check from Eaton Corporation for \$20,000 to use for chromebooks, with

thanks to Mrs. Coffey for securing the grant; our new and improved website is [www.lincoln27.org](http://www.lincoln27.org), and our Reduction in Force Joint Committee annual meeting is required to meet annually before December 1<sup>st</sup> to discuss the way teachers are grouped based on their evaluations and then the overall sequence of dismissal. Member Grunder made a motion, seconded by Member Alexander to approve the report as presented. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.

- FMLA(s) Member Bates made a motion, seconded by Member Alexander, made a motion to approve five Family Medical Leave Act requests as presented. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Tax Abatement Member Bates made a motion, seconded by Member Stoltzenburg, to approve a resolution abating the tax heretofore levied for the Alternate Revenue Bonds Series 2013 totaling \$9,785,000 pledged against the 1% Sales Tax for 2017-18. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Tax Levy Member Hullinger made a motion, seconded by Member Bates, to approve the Tentative Tax Levy and direct the superintendent to file notice and present the levy for passage at the December 2017 regular meeting. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Meeting Date Member Grunder made a motion, seconded by Member Alexander, to change the December meeting date from December 20 to December 13, 2017. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
- Snow Removal Member Bates made a motion, seconded by Member Stoltzenburg, to reimburse First Presbyterian Church for snow removal of the church parking lot while school is in session. All weekends or holidays will be covered by the Church. Members Montgomery, Grunder, Bates, Hullinger, Stoltzenburg, Alexander and Rohrer voted aye to a roll call vote. Motion carried.
